    - b. Sectionals would not be the same.
    - c. Several coaches were on the negative side of this.
  - 4. <u>Motion—Randall Marks (Verona) & a 2<sup>nd</sup> to explore support of Kevin Hopp's Sectional Plan, did</u> not see who seconds the motion, but the motion was seconded.
- B. Jeremy Mosley-All State
  - 1. Summarized

  - 3. Randall Marks—all state should be elite. Same course should be the same as it is now.
